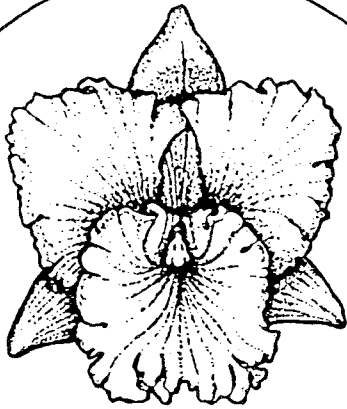

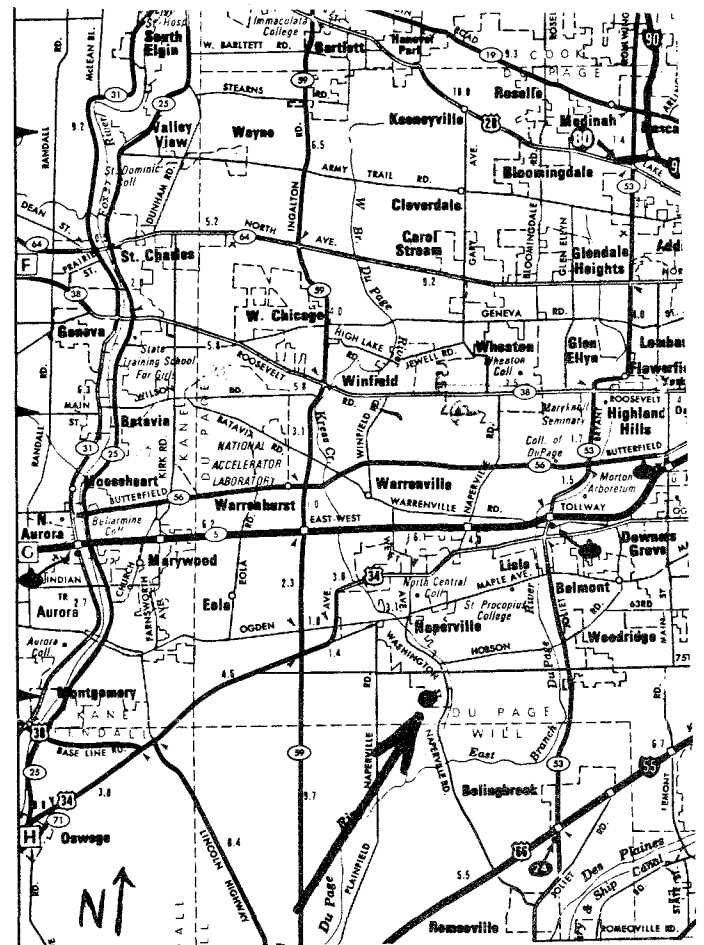
POINT SCORE ACCUMULATIONS

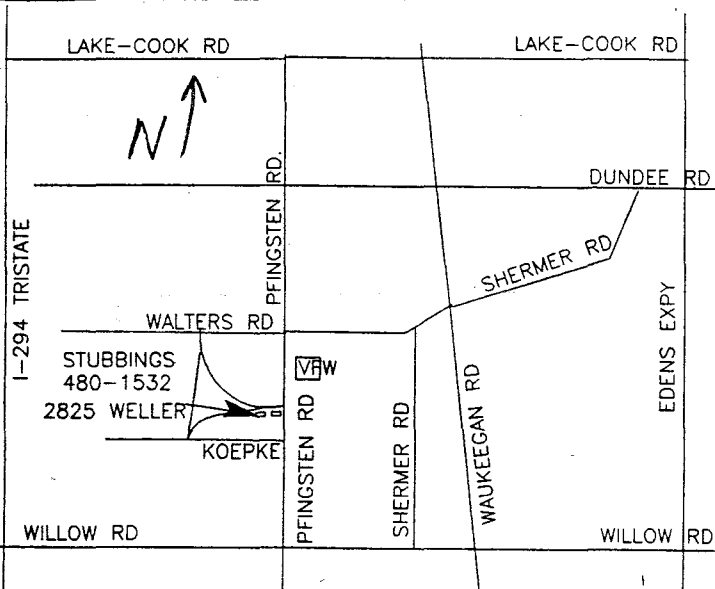
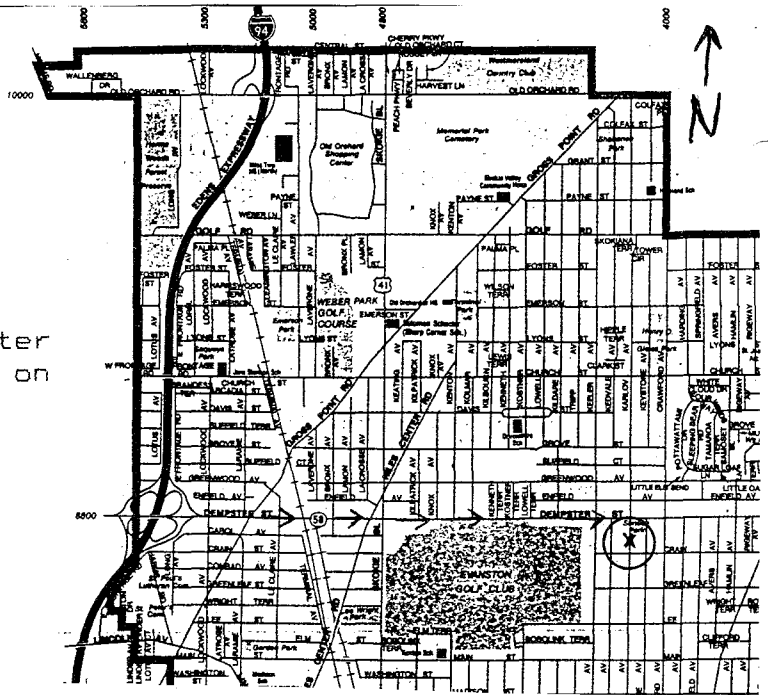

From the north: take I-294 south to I-88 (East-west tollway). Take I-88 west to Rt. 53 exit south. Take Rt. 53 south to 75th St. (approx. 5 miles). Go west (right) on 75th St. approx. 4 miles to Washington St. (4th stoplight). Go south (left) on Washington St. to Foxcroft Ln. (1 mile--there is a White Hen Pantry on the corner). Turn west (right) on Foxcroft for 1 block to Killdeer Ave. Turn north (right) on Killdeer for 1 block to Drendel Ln. Turn west (left) on Drendel for 1/2 block to 65. From the south take I-55 south to Rt. 53 exit north. Go north on Rt. 53 approx. 5 miles to 75th St. Turn west (left) on 75th St. and follow above directions to greenhouse.

From Edens Expressway, exit at Dempster East. Dempster to Karlov. South on Karlov (2nd house on the left).



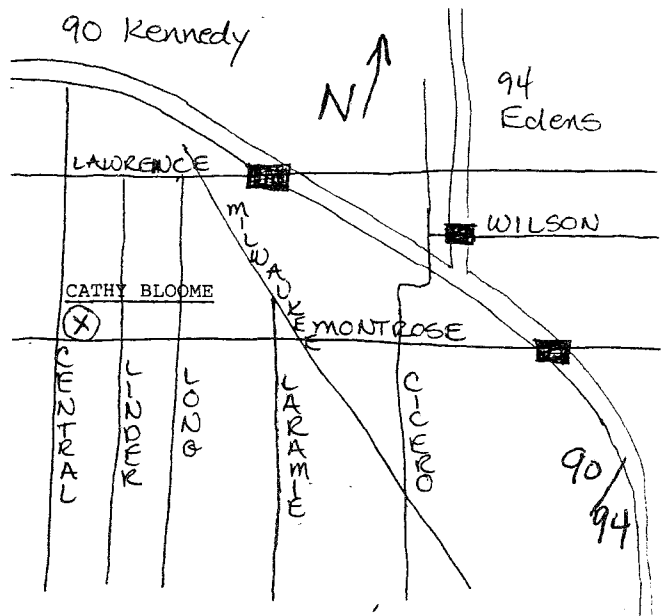

From south: take I-294 to Willow Rd. exit east. Go to Pfingsten Rd. (stop light) and turn north. Take Pfingsten Weller, which only goes west and is 2nd block after Koepke Rd. Or from the north take I-294 and exit Lake-Cook Rd. going east. Take Lake-Cook to Pfingsten and turn right (south) to Weller, which is south of Walters Rd. on the left.

From the north: From Edens, use Wilson exit, make a right and quick left turn to Cicero. Going south to Montrose, about 1/4 mile, turn right, go west just short of a mile, before reaching Central. From the west: From 90/Kennedy, use Lawrence exit, turn right. Go west to Central, 3/4 mile, turn left. Go south to Montrose, 1/2 mile, turn left. Go east 1/4 block. From the south: Go north 90/94 Kennedy, use Montrose exit, turn left. Go west about 1-1/4 miles before reaching Central.

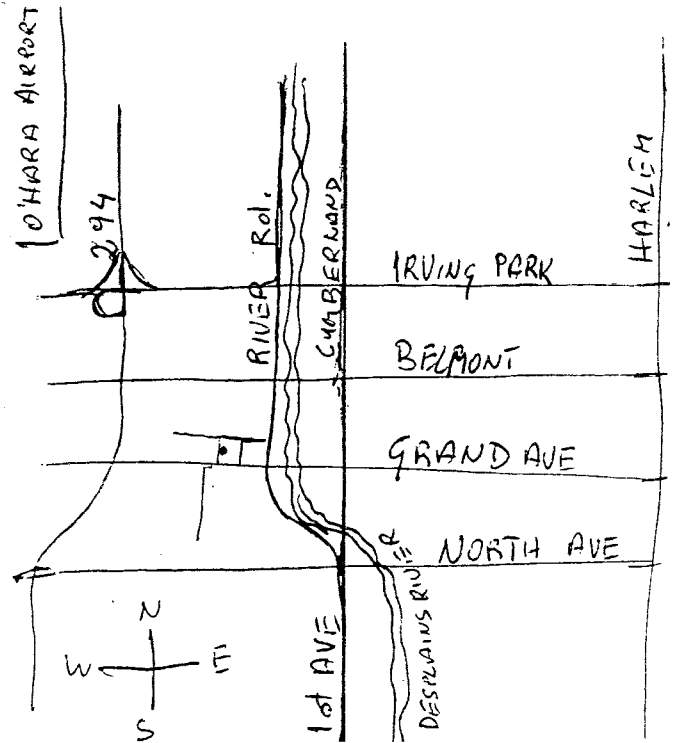
Cathy lives in an apartment upstairs from Mondo Travel on the north side of Montrose and grows orchids under lights.

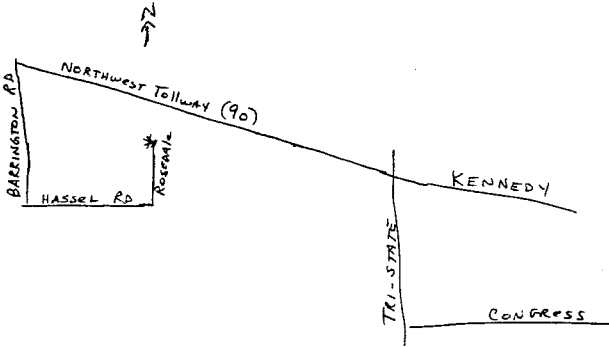
From the north: south to Irving Park, go to River Rd. then south to Grand. Go 2 blocks west to Spruce. Make right to 2721. From the south to the Eisenhower (290) go to 1st Ave. north to Grand. Go west to Spruce, make a right to 2721.

He grows under lights, has homebuilt clean air transfer case and flasks. He will have a lot of phals in bloom and will have plants for sale.

Take any expressway to the Northwest Tollway (90). Take 90 West...Exit Barrington Road (South). Take Barrington Rd to Hassell Road (1st stop light)...Turn left on Hassell to Rosedale (3rd street after 2nd stop sign)...Turn left on Rosedale to 1500.

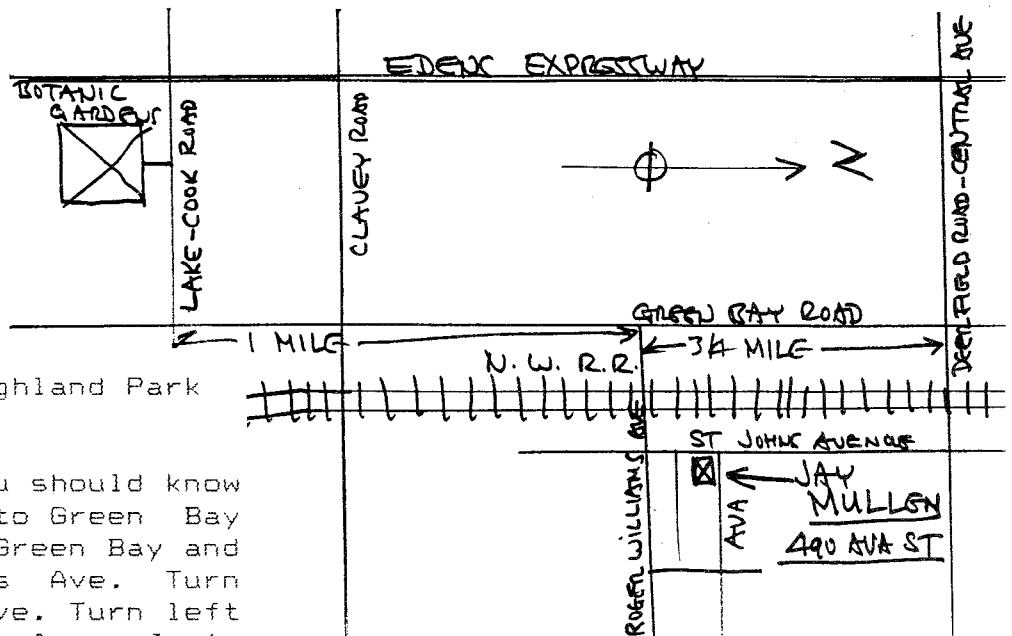

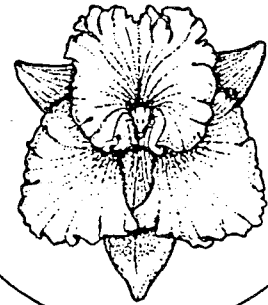
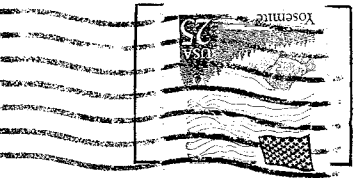
