A CCM to **Bill Rogerson's** L. C. Rojo 'King', beautifully flowered in a 12" pot--174 flowers and 24 buds on 26 inflorescences

A CBR to **Laima Sahagian** for *Epidendrum boothii* 'Laima', beautifully grown by Laima.

294 North or South - exit at Route 22 or Half Day Road - travel east just across tracks to light at 43 or Waukegan Road. Turn left or north 1 block to Old Mill Road. Turn right or east (dead end) to the second driveway on right or 599.

From city - take Eden's (41) to Half Day Road or Route 22. Go west two lights to 43 or Waukegan Rd. Turn right one block to Old Mill Road. Turn right (dead end) or east to 2nd driveway on right or 599.

### **JIM PUPELIS, 458 S. Judson, Bensenville (8-5); 708/860-7652**

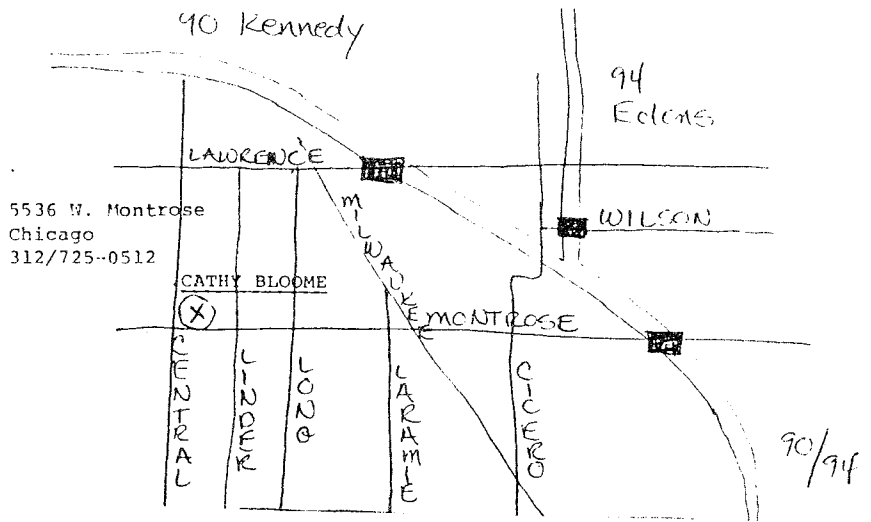
Specializing in paphiopedilums under light, approximately 500 plants of which about 50 are in bloom right now.

**From North:** 294 to Route 19 West (Irving Park Road) to York Road, turn left (south), go 3 stop lights to Jefferson St., turn right on Jefferson, 1/2 mile to Judson. House is on NW corner of Jefferson & Judson.

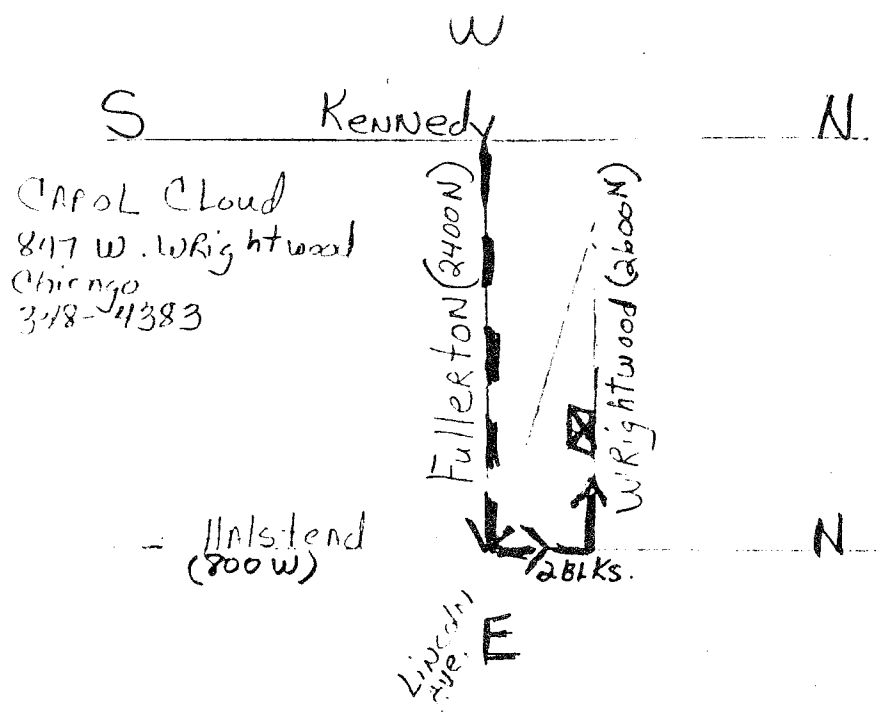
**From West:** NW Tollway east to Rte 53, Rte 53 south to 290 East (Eisenhower) to Route 83 North, to first stop light (Third Avenue), Third Avenue east (right turn), 1/2 mile to Judson. House is on NW corner of Third (Jefferson) and Judson.

**From South:** Tollway 355 South to 290 East or 294 South to 290 West, to Route 83 North, to first stop light (Third Avenue), Third Avenue east (right turn), 1/2 mile to Judson. House is on NW corner of Third (Jefferson) and Judson.

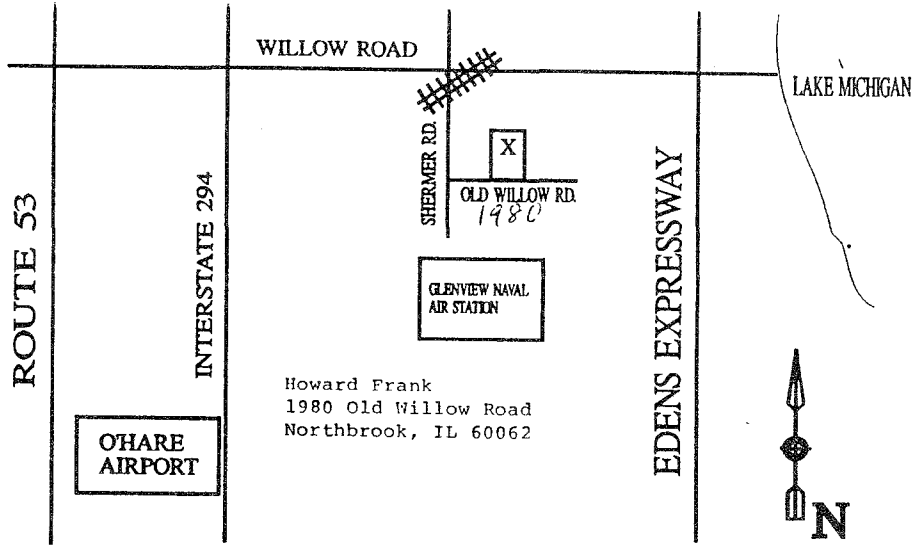
