At the regular supplemental judging in April at the CBG in Glencoe, there were three awards as follows: Phalaenopsis (amboinensis x Scamp) 'Hampshire' HCC-77 pts. **ARNOLD KLEHM, GROWER**; Leptotes bicolor 'Lake Land' CC-82 pts. **RICH JEZIORO**; Dtps. Pretty Nice x Phal. Comanche 'Firestarter' HCC-79 pts. **ORCHIDS BY HAUSERMANN**. Also, **John Stubbings** received two awards at the Regional Judging in St. Louis, on May 4, for his Phalaenopsis Virginia Tucker 'Sandy' AM-80 pts., CCM-84 pts.

Congratulations to all the proud plant owners and growers. Listen, you can hear our applause. A complete list of all AOS awards will be published in the July newsletter. It's an impressive list. Would you like to see your name on next year's list? The only way that can happen is to bring your plants to either the Supplemental Judging in Glencoe, the regional Judging in St. Louis or Ann Arbor, or show them at shows where the IOS has an exhibit. 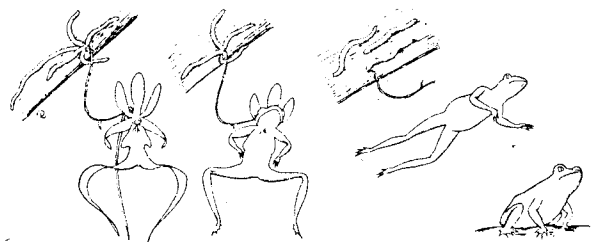

This plant was awarded only last year when it received an AM of 84 points, I believe, at the Hoosier Orchid Society Show in Indianapolis. This flowering had one inflorescence with 6 superb flowers.

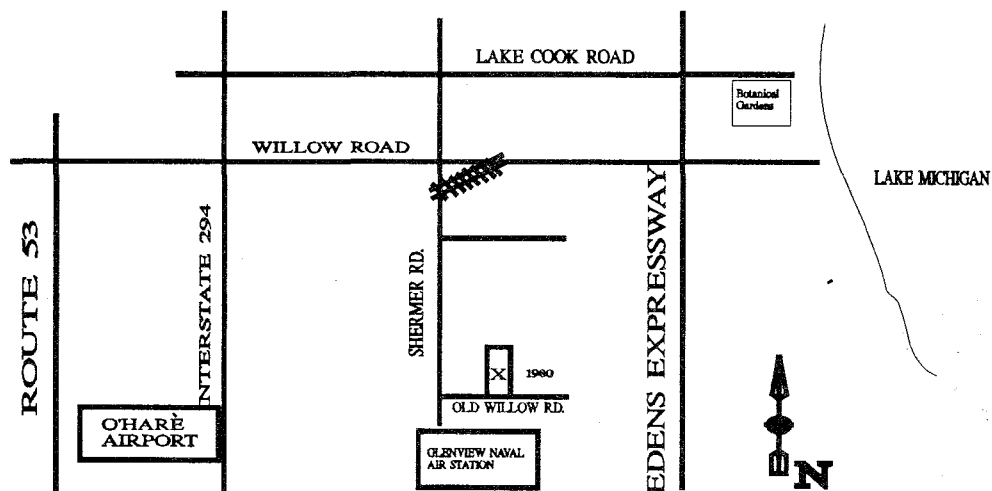

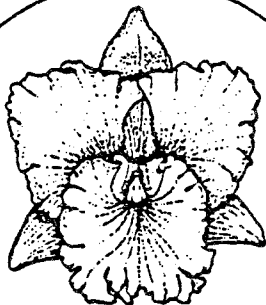
